Love 30, the Campaign for 30 km/h Speed Limits, welcomes the reductions in speed limits brought about by these bye-laws.

We welcome the reduction in speed limits in housing estates. However, the exclusion of certain parts of housing estates from the yellow zones seems inappropriate. And we are disappointed that the 30 km/h speed limits do not apply across wider areas to include schools, shopping centres, and other locations where pedestrians, cyclists, and other vulnerable road users are mixing with vehicular traffic.

Wide-area 30 km/h speed limits provide many benefits:

- Bringing door-to- door improvements, enabling people of all ages to choose active
 travel modes for daily journeys to work, school, or for leisure. In many cases children
 will be able to travel independently to school, thus reducing the school time traffic jams.
 This provides healthy travel options for the whole community and supports climate
 action goals by reducing traffic volumes and associated pollution.
- Are one of the cost effective safety measures. Studies in the UK have found them to be five times more effective at reducing fatal and serious injuries than targeted interventions on A roads.
- Are simpler for all road users. The reduced number of traffic speed signs mean road users don't have to deal with frequent and confusing changes of speed limits.

The Road Traffic Act 2024 has stipulated a default urban speed limit of 30 km/h, so we believe that Meath County Council should be taking the opportunity to reduce speed limits across all urban areas to 30 km/h, with exceptions for certain roads.

Lower speed limits at schools are exceptionally few across County Meath. This is a particular issue at certain locations, like Patrick Street in Trim, where there are four schools, a nursing home and a church on a 250m section of road. While the public consultation was included on meath.ie, it was not included on speedlimits.ie. This is contrary to the statutory "Guidelines for Setting and Managing Speed Limits in Ireland" (2015, amended 2024).

We believe lower speed limits are needed in the following locations, which aren't addressed at all in the bye-laws.

- Clonee Ard Cluain, Clonee Court, Holsteiner Park, Kribensis Manor, Silver Grove, Sterling Square, Summerseat Avenue, Summerseat Barn, Summerseat Close, Summerseat Court, Summerseat Crescent, Summerseat Drive, Summerseat Glen, Summerseat Green, Summerseat House, Summerseat Walk, Summerseat Way, The Gallops Williamstown Stud, The Mayne Estate, and The Orchard.
- Curragha Crickstown Manor, Saint Andrew's, and local access road parallel to R155.
- Fordstown local access roads east and west of cross roads.
- Kilcloon Brownstown, and Clooneen.
- Kilcock (Millerstown, County Meath) Mill Avenue, Mill Brook, Mill Close, Mill Gate, Mill Glen, Mill Park, Mill Stream, Rye Grove, Rye Lane, Rye Water, and The Crescent.
- Kilmoon Cross (Cushinstown) bypassed sections of R152.

- Moynalvy (note, this is NOT the same location as Moynalty) Moynalvy Manor.
- Rathbeggan cul de sac at Growtown.
- Rathcairn Bóthar Uí Ghibealláin, and Garraí Tom Taimín.
- Robinstown (Balbradagh) Balbraddagh Heights, Balbraddagh Park, Clady Meadows, De Verdon Place, Hollybrook and Old Terrace.
- Ahsbourne Large parts of the town will still have a higher speed limits after the implementation of these bye-laws, including Baltrasna Manor, Cherry Court, Churchfields, Cluain Ri, Milltown Meadows, The Oaks, and parts of Archerstown Wood (The Beeches, The Elms, and The Oaks).
- Kells Large parts of the town will still have a higher speed limits after the
 implementation of these bye-laws, including Archdeaconry View, Carrick Court, Carraig
 Dun, Church Lane, Cross Carrick, Lynfield, Maudlin Court, Mill Lane, Mill View, Moy
 Place, Oak Court, Old Cavan Road, The Cloisters, The Deaconry, The Grove, Tiermurrin
 Lane, Townparks Manor, and Wilmount View.
- Various rural residential clusters.

We have provided a detailed list of comments and potential typographic errors in Appendix A, which we hope will be useful to identify gaps in the bye-laws and remove any inconsistencies.

Who We Are

Appendix A

General

- 1. The draft bye-laws seem to be overly-complicated. It would be much easier to draw a line around each location, apply a 30 km/h speed limit to all roads within it and to exclude specific roads if there is a desire to retain a higher speed limit.
- 2. The bye-laws apply multiple legal tests for the 30 km/h speed limits to apply. They must be marked in yellow on the maps (the maps are actually marched in hatched orange) *and* they must be listed in the schedules. This could cause difficulties where there are discrepancies between the text and maps.
- 3. The exclusion of certain parts of housing estates from the yellow zones seems inappropriate.
- 4. Some of the lists of roads are long, e.g. Navan has more than 75 entries. The lists are not necessarily in alphabetical order. Put the lists of roads in alphabetical order. Numbering the lists might be useful (given the length of the lists, roman numerals are not appropriate).
- 5. To avoid confusion and allow for easy searching, use the full name of each road. And check that the names of roads are correct, e.g. "St." versus "Saint".
- 6. Give each estate or road a separate entry in the lists. Composite names like "Ballymore Green/Place/Court/Park" are not appropriate.
- 7. Remove the coloured fonts used to highlight new roads, but retain that text. Highlighting them in the text and on the maps is welcome.
